## RESOURCES FOR OLDER ADULTS

**Health Insurance Counseling and Care Management:** Consultation with experts regarding insurance issues for older adults. Additionally provides support in care planning and implementation

**Senior Community Centers:** Referrals to local senior community centers that offer programs including daily activities, support groups, free/reduced lunches, etc.

**Transportation Services:** Help with acquiring transportation (public and private) for older adults

**Senior Companion Programs:** Matching seniors with companions for help with weekly activities (e.g., groceries) and companionship

**Senior's Farmer's Market:** *Westmoreland Area Agency on Aging ONLY*

**In-Home Services:** Provides home delivered meals. Additionally can provide someone to live in the home, match older adults with a caring family, or can help set up care in a nursing home.

**Legal Services:** Advice in legal areas of finance, guardianship, power-of-attorney, wills, etc.

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## RESOURCES FOR CAREGIVERS

**Direct Services:** Case management, training in caregiving skills, access to support groups, information on benefits and resources, assistance completing benefits and insurance forms.

**Reimbursement Programs:** Some reimbursements provided for out-of-pocket care supplies (e.g., nutritional supplements, incontinence supplies), hired help (e.g., personal care, meal preparation), and home modifications (e.g. grab bars, chair lifts)
